Activity	Description	Timing
LO 1 Apply knowledge from the previous lessons to plan an educational and career path		
Introduction	Introduce the activity and allow students to have a quick look at their booklets. Students will have a booklet one between 2 and a worksheet each	5 mins
Stage 1: Personality types	Students read about a range of personality types using the RIASEC method, noting down which apply to them in Tables A to F. They then add up their points to understand their personality type better.	5 mins
Stage 2: Rules of the game	Take 5 minutes to read through the rules of the game as a class. Students then have a couple of minutes to look through the information booklets.	5 mins
Stage 3:Worked example	As a class walk through David's career path, noting down where and how points are added	5 mins
Stage 4	Students take the majority of the lesson to map out their ideal career routes (or explore career routes) using the information and inputting points and salaries into the 'Decision-making table'	25 mins
Stage 5	Students reflect on their learnings.	5 mins
