| Evolution of communication | Students to read information on how communication has changed over time, with questions linked to how therefore our consumer needs are met | 5 mins |
| Costs associated with mobile phones and key terms | Students to complete key terms matching activity | 3 mins |
| Who can have a mobile phone | Students to identify how a person's personal and employment circumstances might affect whether or not they can have a mobile phone contract | 7 mins |
| LO 2 Compare different mobile phone contracts | | |
| Comparing mobile phone tariffs | Teacher to walk through different mobile phone tariffs, inviting students to share what they think is good and bad about each tariff. | 10 mins |
| Personal reflection - choosing a mobile phone tariff | Students to explain which mobile tariff they would choose and why | 5 mins |
| LO 3 Suggest strategies to manage mobile phone costs | | |
| Managing mobile phone costs | Students to identify how mobile phone costs have the potential to spiral. Teacher to talk through ways to manage mobile phone costs | 10 mins |
| Consolidate | Students to suggest ways of managing mobile phone costs | 5 mins |
